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Highlights about the Hong Kong, China Delegation at the London Olympic Games

- Largest delegation to the Olympic Games after 1997
- With the most participating sports in the Olympic Games (13 sports); only 11 sports in 2008 Beijing Olympic Games
- Sports with the participation of Hong Kong athletes for the first time: Artistic Gymnastics, Weightlifting
- WONG Kam Po, the eldest athletes of the Hong Kong, China Delegation, will be representing Hong Kong in the Cycling Event for the fifth time
- CHOI Nicholas Edward (Fencing) is the youngest athletes of the Hong Kong, China Delegation
